



Summary

Choosing between a daycare and staying at home with a nanny is a decision parents are often forced to make for their young children. Choosing between an intimate connection with a family caregiver and a team of caregivers in a dedicated childcare environment can be tough. Nanny & Me serves to integrate both. Studies show young children do better when their caregivers are responsive, warm, and sensitive; when there is a high ratio of caregivers; and when they are surrounded with rich interactions and language use.

With nannies serving as the common denominator from home, along with a structured developmental program, children will benefit from the best of both worlds.

Program

Nanny & Me is a stimulation program for toddlers and nannies. Our program is designed around core competencies that are key to fine motor, gross motor, speech, cognitive, social, tactile, and creative development.

Whilst the program is fun and stimulating for children, it also serves as a training, bonding, and retention approach for nannies.

With developmental milestone trackers and take-home activities, nannies are encouraged to be more hands-on in the child's development both in and out of playgroup.

- + Possess a genuinely warm, caring and nurturing attitude towards child
- + High school graduate (recommended)
